Helen Frasier, The Cottages at Lochsa Falls Part of The Cottages Family Since March 2024

Born March 1, 1923, in Montour, Idaho, Helen Frasier has lived a life full of adventure, resilience, and deep-rooted family values. At just three years old, she moved with her family to Indian Valley, Idaho, where she and her sister,

Betty, rode their horse, Mouse, 2 miles to school from first through eighth grade. Since Indian Valley didn't yet have a high school, Helen moved to Weiser to live with a friend so she could graduate. She later completed 12th grade and proudly graduated in 1941.

In 1942, Helen married Yard O. Frazier, and together they built a beautiful life, raising six children, two daughters and four sons. She had a deep love for dancing and made sure to take her children out every weekend to the Indian Valley Town Hall, creating cherished memories on the dance floor.

In 1965, Helen and her family moved to Meridian, Idaho, settling on a flatland farm at Cherry Lane and Meadowhill Road. The Frasier family resided on their cattle ranch for 44 years, where Helen's love for the land blossomed. She took great pride in her farm of flowers and vegetables, selling her fresh produce and blooms to the local community. Helen also cultivated corn on her farm, which she sold to the Green Giant Company, contributing to one of the most well-known brands in agriculture. A woman of strength and heart, Helen poured herself into both her family and her passions.

Helen's legacy extends through 16 grandchildren, 9 great-grandchildren, and soon, a great-great-grandchild arriving in April.

In April 2024, Helen moved to The Cottages at Lochsa Falls, where she continues to share her warmth, wisdom, and love for life.

Her story is one of perseverance, joy, and devotion to her family, her farm, and the simple pleasures that made her life so rich.

Helen will be proudly celebrating her 102nd Birthday on March 1st. We are honored to have her as part of our Cottages family!
